


These chemicals can be ducts that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into imment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables ns to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals. on 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts hemicals into sources of drinking water. on 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has nclude approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987. bes of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list? ontains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives ents in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed a may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust. nees a warning mean? ng is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in using, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals more listed chemicals.
